BUT for children in all years, if you receive certain benefits (listed below) the school can also get some additional money to support your children's learning if you register. You can do this by speaking to the office staff or applying online (ctrl + click to follow the link) https://www.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/kent/ You may qualify if you receive any of these benefits:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get). • Income Support. • Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance. • Income-related Employment and Support Allowance. • Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999. • The guaranteed element of Pension Credit. • Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190) • Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.
