Dear Parents and Carers

I hope you have had a good summer break! Not long now and we will be starting another new academic year.

Along with some other reminders, you will also find your newly allocated PE days so you know which days your child can wear their PE Uniform to school instead of their formal uniform. Please take a moment to check that you have the correct items for both uniforms.

These dates can be found in the **'Dates for your Diaries'** and are opportunities for parents to here about expectations, curriculum and other relevant information from your child's year group staff.

Change to Length of School Day

The Department for Education (DFE) has an initiaive to ensure that all schools are offering 32.5 hours per week. This requires all school to provide a 6.5 hour day. Our previous school day was 5 minutes short so we will be be increasing this from September. We will continue to start school at 8.50am (school will still open gates at 8.30am). We will now be opening our gates at the end of the day at 3.20pm with collection required by 3.30pm.

Break Time Snacks

Year R, 1 and 2 are provided with mid morning snacks so parents do not need to provide them. KS2 (Years 3 – 6) can bring in a snack which is limited to a piece of fruit, vegetables (see the list below). Snack time is a brief time during the morning and the children will only have time to eat one item. Children will not be permitted to eat items from their packed lunch or things such as crisps, chocolate bars etc. We can allow:

- Any fresh fruit
- Dried fruit eg raisins, apricots, etc
- Vegetables eg carrots, peppers, mini tomatoes
- Fruit alternatives such as fruit winders
- Breadsticks
- Small cheese portion eg Babybel



Term Time Absences

Please remember that you need to request authorisation for any non-medical, non-illness absences during term time. There is a form that needs completing **before** the absence. This form can be found on our website <u>www.headcorn.kent.sch.uk</u> or you can get a paper copy from the school office.

Medical Appointments

Attendance is very important as each session that your child is absent they are missing important learning time. Where possible please make any medical appointments or check ups such as opticians, dentists, etc after school or during the holidays. We will not be able to release siblings for any appointments that are emergency or necessary during the school day.

Please try to send everything your child needs for the day in with them. We understand that items can be forgotten at times however please note the following:

- Guitars and other instruments need to be sent in with your child. If they forget their instrument then they will be able to borrow from the teacher or another pupil. Please do not bring these to the school office.
- Water bottles do not need to be dropped in as we have spares to use for those children who have forgotten them.
- Lunchboxes we can order a lunch from the catering company. Please phone the office to arrange this.
